

MORAN ON TOP

Leon Moran continued his push to be the lowest marker in the club with a polished 39 points to claim victory in the Stableford event held last Saturday. Clayton Flynn tallied 37 points this week for a win in the Leisure Day competition. Wayne Waywood had 35 to be next best in the small field of 5 participants.
