

## **STEWART RETAINS CLUB CHAMPIONSHIP CROWN**

Stewart returned a best gross score of 75 to improve his three round total by one. Leon Moran made that stroke necessary, also recording a 75 to miss forcing a tie by one stroke. The club's two low markers finished on 227 and 228 respectively. Danny Cheng, who sponsored the last round, was third in the championship on a total of 239.

Peter Walsh had a great day to win the nett event with a score of 68. Stephen Farquhar and Leon Moran filled the minor placings on 69. They were followed by George Davis and Frank Battista on 70.

52 players competed in the Golden Bowl sponsored event with the CCR being 71.

Jim Moyses and Ken Tate were rewarded for their score of 71 and those on 73 also got a mention, including Mike Daley, Ross Davidson, Ash Stewart and Phil Warburton.

Nearest the pins went to Ken Woods, John Michalak and Fed Bronickis. David Laird and John Brown won the long putts and Jaydon Ellery took the long drive.
